

Clematis

Barton Nurseries Fact Sheet

Early Spring Flowering Varieties require no pruning and are easy to grow in any aspect. **Montanas, Macropetalas and Alpinas.**

Big Flowered Early Summer Varieties require a light prune after flowering. **Multi Blue, Fireworks, Guernsey Cream, Daniel Deronda, Westerplatte, Niobe and Vyvyan Pennell.** Most of these varieties flower twice and are good for pots.

Evergreen Varieties **Early Sensation** (spring flowering) and the winter flowering **Cirrhus's Freckles** and **Wisley Cream.**

Summer Flowering Varieties require a hard chop back in Spring. **Vitticella's – Betty Corning, Polish Spirit, Purpurea, Plena, Elegans, Alba Lux, Rubra and Minuet Texensis Princess Diana, Texensis Etoile Rose and Tangutica.**

The longest flowering clematis are the Florida Sieboldii and Florida Alba Plena (Flore Plena). These flower from May through to the Autumn and are great for pots.

Scented Varieties **Aromatica, Triternata Rubromarginata (TRM), Flammula, Betty Corning and Montana Elizabeth.** (All summer flowering bar the Montana).

Feed all clematis regularly, Tomorite or Osmocote are a good choice.
